**Prevent Suicide PA, Govan A. Martin and Mary Brown  
(No fee for conference registrants)**

Govan A. Martin, III is the Chair/Board of Directors of Prevent Suicide PA. For five years, he was Co-Chair of the Pennsylvania Adult/Older Adult Suicide Prevention Coalition. He is a survivor of his brother, Michael's suicide who died in 1980. Govan retired from the PA State Police (PSP) in 2012 after serving 29 years. During his tenure in the PSP, he was instrumental and helped create/write legislation for Confidentiality for Law Enforcement Peer Support and Critical Incidents in 2010. Govan is currently a consultant/trainer on Suicide Prevention and Critical Incident Stress Management. Trainings that he conducts include; (Master Trainer) in QPR (Question Persuade Refer), ASIST (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training), Group Crisis Intervention, Assisting Individuals in Crisis, and Psychological First Aid. He has given multiple and varied trainings concerning suicide prevention across the Commonwealth and throughout the country.

Mary Brown has been employed with Community Connections of Clearfield/Jefferson Counties since 1998. Mary is currently the Crisis Program Specialist; she oversees the County Delegates and the two County Crisis systems. She is the Disaster Crisis Outreach Referral Team (DCORT) Coordinator; her team is called when a mental health intervention is warranted after a crisis such as a natural disaster. Mary is a certified trainer for Mental Health First Aid for Adults, Youth and Public Safety; Question, Persuade, and Refer (QPR) suicide prevention Master trainer and a trainer for Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST). Mary has been a Board member of Prevent Suicide PA for five years; the Coalition sponsors statewide education and outreach, and supports the efforts of local suicide prevention task forces in the Commonwealth. Mary was instrumental in organizing the Clearfield Jefferson Suicide Prevention Team ten years ago; she is currently the Team Coordinator.
